LEGAL NOTICE, TRAVERSE CITY, MICHIGAN, March 11, 2024 - The Area Agency on Aging (AAANM) seeks feedback on its FY2025 Annual Implementation Plan (AIP) which impacts older adults and caregivers. The AIP is a guide for the development and funding of aging programs and services in Northwest Michigan under the Older Americans Act and other State funding sources.
