# FENCE REGU 



SITE PLAN APPLICATION WITH SURVEY/DRAWING MUST BE SUBMITTED AND APPROVED PRIOR, TO INSTALLATION

## The following regulations apply to all fences, walls, screens, or similar devices:

A fence, wall or screen other than plant material shall:

- be no greater than 42 inches in the front yard;
- be no greater than 8 feet in any side or rear yard, except for tennis court enclosures located completely in a rear yard;
- not obstruct vision or interfere with vehicular or pedestrian traffic;
- have the most visually appealing side constructed to face away from the property on which it is constructed;
- be within the boundaries of the parcel, unless the adjacent property owner has provided written approval to the Zoning Administrator that it may be constructed on the property line.

> No higher than 8 feet in side or rear yard

No higher than 3.5 feet
in front yard $\square$

A site plan application and survey drawing indicating location for the fence in relation to the primary structure, property boundaries and fence height must be submitted and approved prior to installation. A fee of $\$ 30$ must be submitted with the application.
