

MI Choice Waiver Program



- MI Choice Waiver program allows individuals that require nursing home level of care to receive that care in their or a family member's home or community-based residence of their choosing.
- Support and services are available to individuals who meet medical, income and asset criteria.
- Available to individuals that are Medicaid eligible with limited monthly income-not household income; please contact our Options Counselors to determine financial criteria as amount changes annually.



An individual must show a need for home or residential-based service.



Referrals may be made by any individual, such as a family member, friend, medical provider or social worker.

Getting Started is Easy:

- In order to qualify, a person must be disabled or over 65 and eligible for Medicaid.
- Contact an Options Counselor at 231-733-3585 to discuss potential eligibility.
- If eligible, a Supports Coordinator will contact the individual and/or individual's representative and schedule a home visit. The Supports Coordinator will:
 - Complete an in-depth assessment of the individual to confirm eligibility.
 - Work with the applicant or applicant's representative to develop a person centered care plan that may provide the support and services required to allow the individual to reside as comfortably as possible wherever they call home.
